Bob Wasylyshen holds an outstanding record of accomplishment as Chief of Police and operational officer with the Edmonton Police Service, an organization that comprised approximately 2,650 staff and volunteers. During 33 years of exemplary service, he developed and strengthened already strong community relationships and service delivery appropriate to the needs of a diverse, multicultural community. He also led an investigation of allegations of corruption within the Service and initiated the development of a wide variety of programs such as:

- Practical Leadership Skills for Police Officers (also handled training)
- Public Service Area Concept of Community Policing (also handled training)
- Gang Activity Suppression Team to address emerging gang-related violence
- If You Drink and Drive – You're a Bloody Idiot (an anti-drunk driving program)
- Aboriginal Resource Officer Program

More recently, he acted as a consultant to Alberta's Solicitor General on the province's Special Constable Program, as an Interim CAO for a city with a population of 23,000, as a principal investigator for an operational review of a city's bylaw enforcement services and fire department, and as a consultant on the assessment of the sustainability of protective services infrastructure for a large, sparsely populated northern County.
